

**INTERNATIONAL SENIOR OFFICER  
AMPHIBIOUS PLANNING**

**MASL P171007**                      **Duration: 10 weeks**  
**ECL 70**                              **Officer O-5 – O-7**  
**By invitation only, offered once per year**

**Selective waivers** to a limited number of O-4 equivalent naval officers, and O-5 to O-7 ground and air forces officers are offered. A minimum of 8 students is required to conduct the class and a maximum of 24.



**Description:** Introductory instruction includes naval and landing force expeditionary warfare organizations, doctrine, equipment, communications, employment of supporting arms, and logistical support of an expeditionary warfare operation.

Follow-on instruction includes joint naval/landing force expeditionary warfare planning concepts and procedures, and culminates with students developing a plan in support of a major expeditionary warfare operation. Students also research, write and present a paper on a major amphibious operation. The course includes Field Study Program (FSP) activities.

INTERNATIONAL COURSES**

**Amphibious Warfare Indoctrination**

**MASL P124250**                      **Duration: 1 week**  
Provides comprehensive indoctrination in amphibious techniques, planning, ship-to-shore movement, supporting arms, tactical air and landing force organization.

**Expeditionary Warfare Staff Planning**

**MASL P124251**                      **Duration: 1 week**  
**Prerequisite: Amphibious Warfare Indoctrination (P124250)**

Trains officers and noncommissioned officers in the knowledge and skills required for the operational planning and employment of Marine Air-Ground Task Forces (MAGTFs).

**Tactical Air Control Party**

**MASL P124031**                      **Duration: 4 weeks**  
Provides training in the joint tactics, techniques, and procedures used for controlling and integrating the broad spectrum of fire support and air power available to the MAGTF Commander or Joint Task Force (JTF) Commander. Includes a 3-day live fire exercise.

**Naval Gunfire Liaison Officer**

**MASL P124265**                      **Duration: 7 weeks**  
Provides training for officers and NCOs for duty as naval gunfire liaison personnel with Marine Corps divisions and other units.



**Landing Craft Air Cushion (LCAC)  
Craftmaster Crew**

**MASL P124322**                      **Duration: 17 weeks**  
Provides knowledge and skills to operate the LCAC in normal, emergency, and degraded modes over water and land in all conditions.

**LCAC Navigator Crew Training**

**MASL P124323**                      **Duration: 17 weeks**  
Provides the information, skill development, and practical application on high speed radar navigation, tactical maneuvering and communication techniques for LCAC operation.

**LCAC Engineer Crew Training**

**MASL P124324**                      **Duration: 17 weeks**  
Emphasizes craft engineer duties specifically in the area of electrical and mechanical systems, operation and control systems.

**Expeditionary Fires Primer**

**MASL P124519**                      **Duration: 1 week**  
Reviews the various supporting arms, principles of fire support planning, role of intelligence, and targeting in fire support planning and execution.

**LCAC Propulsion and Lift System Maintenance**

**MASL P145555**                      **Duration: 7 weeks**  
Provides information, skill development, and practical application to set up, check out, and maintain the LCAC gas turbine engines, propulsion and lift system and mechanical auxiliaries.

**LCAC Craft Control System Maintenance**

**MASL P145556**                      **Duration: 5 weeks**  
Provides orientation, skill development, and practical application to perform maintenance on LCAC electrical power distribution, main engine controls, fuel system, fire protection system and craft control systems.

**LCAC Officer Indoctrination**

**MASL P129575**                      **Duration: 1 week**  
Provides assault craft personnel, CWO through O-6, with understanding of unit organizations, LCAC characteristics & terminology, Safe Engineering & Operations (SEOPS) manuals, mission planning, normal operations, craft tactics, and lessons learned.

## International Coalition Staff Planning

ECL 70

Duration: 5 weeks  
Officer O-1 – O-7

Offered once per year

This course prepares officers and noncommissioned officers to function effectively and efficiently for planning of expeditionary warfare, humanitarian assistance and disaster relief operations. Introduces the amphibious operations, ship-to-shore movement, supporting arms, landing force and amphibious organization and their functions. The course consists of 3 weeks in classroom and 2 weeks in the Joint Expeditionary Warfare Laboratory applying hands-on war gaming application.

The MTT will supplement the above resident course through dedicated on-site instruction and a simulation- based war game.
