GENTEXT/REMARKS/1. THE NAVAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING SECURITY ASSISTANCE FIELD ACTIVITY (NETSAFA), IN COORDINATION WITH THE MARINE CORPS SECURITY COOPERATION GROUP, WILL CONDUCT A MARITIME INTERNATIONAL MILITARY STUDENT OFFICER (IMSO) WORKSHOP FROM 8-11 FEB 2016 IN PENSACOLA, FL.

2. THE MARITIME IMSO WORKSHOP IS A WORKING LEVEL MEETING FOR COMMAND PERSONNEL MOST INVOLVED WITH THE ADMINISTRATION OF INTERNATIONAL MILITARY STUDENTS (IMS) AND THE FIELD STUDIES PROGRAM (FSP). ALL IMSOS OR ASST IMSOS ARE ENCOURAGED TO SEEK ATTENDANCE. THIS WORKSHOP IS A VALUABLE TOOL FOR THOSE WHO PROVIDE SUPPORT TO INTERNATIONAL MILITARY STUDENTS RECEIVING TRAINING AT USN, USMC AND USCG SCHOOLS AND OPERATIONAL COMMANDS. IT IS A FORUM USED TO DISCUSS PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED IN THE MANAGEMENT OF IMS, SHARE IDEAS, AND OBTAIN INFORMATION ON THE LATEST SECURITY COOPERATION TRAINING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES. PROPOSED AGENDA TOPICS INCLUDE A CROSS CULTURAL PRESENTATION AND BRIEFS ON IMSO DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES, IMSO BEST PRACTICES, SANWEB, TLA, FSP, AND A MEDICAL ISSUES/MEDICAL POLICY REVIEW UPDATE.

3. ALL USMC COMMAND IMSOS ARE ASKED TO IDENTIFY ADDITIONAL AGENDA TOPICS OF INTEREST, ISSUES, OR QUESTIONS THEY WOULD LIKE TO SEE ADDRESSED DURING THE WORKSHOP. COMMAND OR SCHOOL WILL NORMALLY BE CONSIDERED FOR FUNDED ATTENDANCE.

5. IMSO OF THE YEAR AWARD. THE USMC IMSO OF THE YEAR AWARD WILL BE PRESENTED AT THE WORKING GROUP. ACTIVITIES SHOULD SUBMIT NOMINATIONS, WITH JUSTIFICATION, IN LETTER FORMAT TO TECOM G3-5-7 WITH APPROPRIATE ENDORSEMENTS. NOMINATIONS ARE DUE NLT 18 DECEMBER 2015. IMSO OF THE YEAR AWARD NOMINEES MAY BE OFFICER, ENLISTED, CIVILIAN, IMSO OR ASSISTANT IMSO, AND MUST HAVE SERVED IN AN IMSO CAPACITY FOR AT LEAST ONE YEAR. THE IMSO OF THE YEAR WILL BE JUDGED ON OVERALL PROGRAM EFFECTIVENESS, PERSONAL INITIATIVE AND EXTRAORDINARY ACHIEVEMENTS. SUBMISSIONS SHOULD ADDRESS IMSO PERFORMANCE IN THE FOLLOWING:

- STUDENT THROUGHPUT
- ADMINISTRATION OF IMS IN COMPLIANCE WITH INSTRUCTIONS
- CREATIVITY, THOROUGHNESS AND EFFECTIVENESS OF THE FIELD STUDIES PROGRAM
- ASSISTANCE PROVIDED TO OTHER IMSOS
- PERSONAL INTERFACE AND EFFECTIVENESS WHEN MANAGING ISSUES FACING IMS AND THEIR DEPENDENTS
