## ***COURSES***

### **Resident & Mobile Training Team (MTT)**

#### **AMPHIBIOUS AIRSPACE OPERATIONS COORDINATION - 2 days**

##### **Course MASL # P124054**

Provides personnel (E5 through O5) with training in the airspace control systems used in expeditionary and amphibious operations. Emphasis is placed on the systems established to support Amphibious Task Forces and Marine Air-Ground Task Forces.

#### **AMPHIBIOUS WARFARE INDOCTRINATION - 5 days**

##### **Course MASL # P124503 MTT: P309196**

Provides a comprehensive indoctrination in amphibious operations, to include planning, ship-to-shore movement, supporting arms, tactical air, and landing force organization and functions to orient officers and enlisted personnel (E6 through E9).

#### **EXPEDITIONARY WARFARE STAFF PLANNING - 5 days**

##### **Course MASL # P124507 MTT: P309197**

Provides Marine Corps and Navy personnel (E5 through O6) with the concepts and procedures required for the operational planning and employment of Marine Air-Ground Task Forces as part of naval expeditionary forces participating in expeditionary operations.

#### **FIRE SUPPORT COORDINATION CENTER - 10 days**

##### **Course MASL # P124505 - 10 days**

Provides Army, Navy, and Marine Corps personnel with the doctrine, techniques and procedures for planning and coordinating fire support for a MAGTF employed in expeditionary operations.

#### **STABILITY OPERATIONS - 5 days**

##### **Course MASL # P173800 MTT: P309199**

Provides instruction to civilian and military personnel in an overview of Military Operations Other Than War (MOOTW), with a focus on Peace Operations and closely related subsets including Humanitarian Assistance. The course teaches terms, definitions, concepts, the legal basis for command and control structures, planning considerations, and case studies.

#### **TACTICAL AIR CONTROL PARTY COURSE - 20 days**

##### **Course MASL # P124514**

Provides Marine aviation officers for duty as air officers and forward air controllers. Officers will be qualified for assignment to the Marine Division Tactical Air Control Parties and Air Naval Gunfire Liaison Company.

#### **MARITIME PRE-POSITIONING FORCE STAFF PLANNING - 5 days**

##### **Course MASL # P124125**

Provides Marine Corps, Navy, Coast Guard, Merchant Marine, Army personnel (E5 through O6), and civilian equivalents with the knowledge and skills required in the operational planning tasks performed by command and staff personnel of Navy forces and Marine Corps major subordinate elements assigned to the Maritime Pre-positioning Force.
