Ms. Janie Glover is a career civil servant currently serving as Deputy Director for the Naval Education and Training Security Assistance Field Activity (NETSAFA) located in Pensacola, FL. NETSAFA is responsible for the administration and management of the U.S. Navy's Security Cooperation Education and Training Programs that support U.S. security strategy in building partner capacity to strengthen enduring international partnerships.



Ms. Glover is the senior NETSAFA civilian and oversees the effective management of programs that annually involve the training of more than 6,000 international military students from more than 150 countries attending courses in Navy schools and institutions throughout the United States. An additional 8,000 students are trained in their home countries by team members from U.S. Navy training sites and other organizations annually. The annual dollar value of this training is in excess of \$162M.

Prior to being selected as Deputy Director, Ms. Glover served as Program Management Department Head (Operations Officer) for more than seven years. She has worked Department of the Navy (DON) Security Cooperation Education and Training Programs in all Combatant Commands with the majority of her career being in PACOM. While a Country Program Manager, Ms. Glover also served as IMSO Manager, DISAM-TO Navy unique instructor, IMSO Workshop coordinator and presenter. Prior to working as a Country Program Manager at NETSAFA, Ms. Glover worked as a Financial Manager.

Ms. Glover holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Education from Eastern Illinois University and a Global Master of Arts in International Affairs from The Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy at Tufts University. She was a 2004 recipient of the U.S. Navy's Meritorious Civilian Award.
